




A cooler-climate growing region, California’s expansive North Coast appellation is known for producing world-class Chardonnays thanks to its warm daytime temperatures being kept in check at night by the cooling breezes and sea fogs which creep in from the nearby Pacific ocean.

Our *Burnside Road 2020 North Coast Chardonnay* displays aromas of ripe pear and brown spice with gentle hints of white chocolate.



A medium-bodied, intriguing Chardonnay, lively flavors of baked peach, honeydew melon and vanilla mingle with a precisely-balanced acidity leading to a smooth, textured finish of brioche, lemon zest and nutmeg.

Perfect as a summer sip, this artful wine also pairs naturally with oven-roasted chicken, buttery grilled corn on the cob or creamy mushroom risotto


The high elevation Red Hills, Lake County AVA is fast gaining recognition for its distinctive Cabs. Located on the south-west shore of Clear Lake, in the northern Mayacamas Mountains, the grapes typically enjoy a long hang time as hot summer days are cooled by gentle Pacific breezes.

Our Burnside Road 2020 Red Hills, Lake County Cabernet Sauvignon has pronounced aromas of raspberry leading to cherry, cinnamon and rich coffee flavors which fuse on the full, satisfying palate.



The nuanced finish is long and complex with hints of licorice and leather showcasing soft tannins and a well-balanced acidity.

We recommend pairing this wine alongside blue cheese-topped burgers with caramelized onion, hearty shepherd's pie or herb mashed potatoes.


Sonoma County's Dry Creek Valley has been held as one of California's most prized Zin-growing regions since the 1800s. Its well-drained soils and warmer temperatures make it home to many old-growth vineyards producing famously ripe grapes which retain complexity and balance.

Our 2019 Burnside Road Dry Creek Valley Zinfandel offers intense aromas of jammy raspberry and plum. The mouthfeel is rich and vibrant with an array of pronounced dark fruit flavors laced with cinnamon, caramel and lively black pepper.



A delightful finish of cherry, cocoa powder and nutty tannins lingers alongside a perfectly-balanced, fresh acidity.

We recommend pairing with hearty dishes such as grilled eggplant, braised short ribs or beef tenderloin.

Intersected by the beautiful Russian River, Sonoma County’s famed Alexander Valley AVA enjoys a consistently warm growing season, cooled by morning Pacific fogs. Combined with gravelly soils, these conditions produce perfectly ripe grapes and world-class Cabernet Sauvignons.

Our *Burnside Road 2020 Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon* boasts pronounced aromas of berry and plum framed by a hint of vanilla and sandalwood.



The rich palate offers enticing flavors of blackberry and dark chocolate alongside typical Cab notes of tobacco and leather, leading to a balanced acidity and well-formed, nutty tannins on the nuanced and layered finish.

Drinking great now, we recommend pairing this wine with rib-eye steak, pan-seared tuna or mushroom quiche.
