2015 Lodi Zinfandel

Lodi is renowned for its full-bodied and jammy zinfandels. With a classic warm Mediterranean climate tempered by evening breezes, its near-ideal growing conditions mean Lodi can justifiably proclaim itself the “Zin Capital of the World”.

Our *Longvale* Lodi Zinfandel is an outstanding example of this premium wine region.

Tasting Notes

Aromas: Caramel, baked cherry pie, savory spices, a slight smokiness.

Palate: Intense dark berry flavors followed by clove and dark chocolate with a touch of oaky vanilla. Full-bodied but finely balanced with a lasting impression of licorice, fig and subtle black pepper.

Aging: Drinking well now; age for up to three years

Pairing: Pair with hearty Italian sausages, blue cheese burgers or grilled red bell pepper.
